

CUCUMERIS

Amblyseius cucumeris is used for the prevention, control and management of various thrips species.

Cucumeris are tough predators that **prefer the immature stages of thrips** and can also have an impact on various mites.



CROPS

Citrus, grapes, dates, blueberries, cannabis, Macadamias, avocado, strawberries & various vegetable crops.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The adults can be stored prior to release if necessary but not for longer than 2 days.

- Cucumeris are sold & supplied in adult form.
- Sprinkle the contents of the bottle on leaves of affected plants/trees at head height & if possible, in close proximity to mites.
- Once applied, the adult mites will start dispersing immediately and start looking for prey.

RELEASE TIPS

Cucumeris are best released in early spring & summer, before thrips populations build up to high levels. In Citrus orchards, releases should be considered after the spring complex sprays are complete. Do not release Cucumeris too soon after applying toxic chemicals & avoid harsh chemical applications after insects are introduced.
